

# **Proposal for Siuslaw Vision**

## **Project Partnership Agreement (PPA)**

### ***Building a better Siuslaw community together***

Thank you for your interest in partnering with Siuslaw Vision! The Vision is a grassroots, community-led effort to enhance opportunities in the Siuslaw region. We collaborate with Siuslaw residents and groups to help them achieve their dreams. The Vision includes a broad list of interests: jobs and economic development, health and human services, education, infrastructure and public services, arts and culture, and recreation and the environment. We look forward to learning more about your community building idea!

Siuslaw Vision project partnerships focus on **community-led action**. The intent of a project partnership is to support your idea by adding limited organizational capacity from our staff and volunteers. This could include connecting you to other people working on something similar, helping your group convene meetings, providing project management templates, suggesting ways your group could raise funds, sharing your event or project with the community, and serving as the official host of your project or event. Your project group is expected to lead the effort and make the project happen with our support. For most projects, your team will also need to raise the funds needed for the project. Siuslaw Vision also offers fiscal sponsorship and fee for services work if additional staff support is needed.

We will confirm its receipt and a likely next step is that we will contact you to learn more about your project. From there, our staff and Vision Team will review your proposal to see if we can provide services you are requesting. If so, we'll work together to develop a Project Partnership Agreement.

When making a decision about what kind of support Siuslaw Vision can provide your project, we consider the following:

- Does the project align with Siuslaw Vision's mission and focus areas?
- Does the project fit any of Siuslaw Vision's identified annual priorities and work plan items?
  - Project aligns with Vision focus area or identified priority
  - 2026 priorities include: community connections, child care capacity, ideas to action projects, parks and recreation planning, emergency resilience support
- What is the estimated cost of the project, and
  - Does the community group have the means to share costs or raise funds?
  - Does Siuslaw Vision have funds allocated in its budget?
- Does the project have a community champion/leader (preferably two to share the work load)?
- Is there demonstrated community energy and engagement?
  - Team of people working together
  - Commitment from a partner organization
- Does the project have a start and end date within 0-18 months (not an ongoing or long-term project)
- Does the project have support and committed capacity from SV Team, Staff, or Board members?
  - The applicant does not need to have this in place; we will evaluate this with our groups.
